Our mission for students who participate in this University Program is to equip them for their future careers and empower them to make a positive impact in the kingdom of God as devoted followers of Christ. These students are spread out throughout all of Honduras. We have mentors in place to help guide these students through the unique challenges they face navigating their first years of independence having left the confines of the orphanage walls to prepare them to face the challenges of life after graduation. Leveraging our network, we assist students in securing internships and job opportunities while they pursue their education.

Recently, we welcomed our 10th student into our alumni university program. We learned that one of our generous donors had been supporting a young girl from Hogar Amor over the past few years. We feel incredibly fortunate to have a dedicated community actively involved in the lives of the children we support.

She is entering the final stages of her studies and will start her internship soon. Point Honduras: Bringing Hope to Vulnerable Communities

In the heart of Tegucigalpa, Point Honduras operates in neighborhoods where danger lurks around every corner. These areas, plagued by gang activity, are deemed untouchable by banks and even other nonprofit organizations due to their high risk.

In these gang-infested neighborhoods, Point faces an uphill battle. Gangs exert control over every aspect of life, even access to basic necessities like water. Their influence is pervasive, and no property remains untouched by their reach. Whenever we visit these neighborhoods, it is necessary to be in a vehicle with a Point sticker on the outside. This seemingly small act is essential for safe passage. Without it, notorious groups like MS13 would block the way.

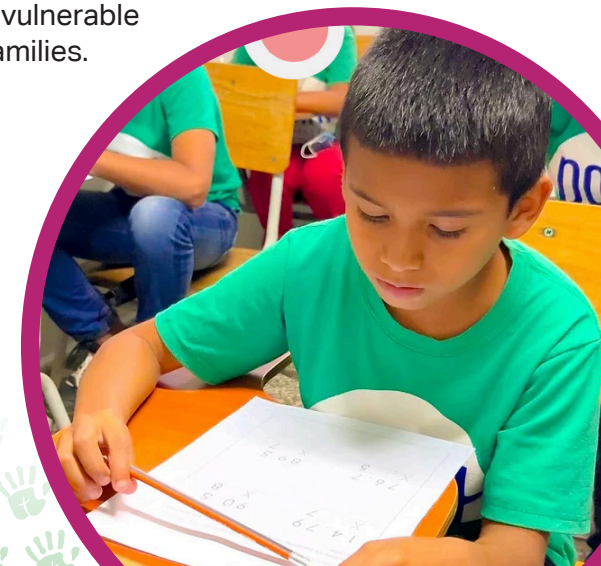
The children in these neighborhoods face a lot of adversity, especially when they lack the resources to be able to attend school. But Point Honduras stands firm, supporting them and encouraging them towards different life paths than those of the gangs. Point remembers that whenever we serve the least of these we are also serving Jesus.

Point Honduras' dreams are not complete. They envision a Christian school, K-12, offering holistic education to the city's poorest children allowing them to reach more orphaned and at-risk youth. Through education, Point aims to break the cycle of poverty and vulnerability. Their commitment to the Gospel drives them forward, one child at a time.

Recently, Point faced a critical juncture regarding the fate of its main facility. Despite significant upgrades that transformed it into a cutting-edge building, its survival was threatened. The owner, dissuaded by the area's reputation, decided to put it up for sale. However, we recognize the immense value of Point's presence and are seeking support to raise funds for its purchase.

Point's mission transcends mere physical well-being; it is fueled by faith and a compassionate commitment to divine love. Their dedication revolves around offering care, hope, and healing to the most vulnerable. By generously contributing to AGC, we can prevent Point from having to relocate.
