"We've had a wonderful first trimester this year. As always, we maintained operations in all 4 of our centers, where we provide food from Monday to Friday to all

800 students who also receive free tutoring and accessible healthcare in our three Point health clinics. Once again with joy and gratitude, all of the students in our programs received free school supplies, school uniforms, shoes, and backpacks.

We are so grateful for the groups the Lord blesses

us with. They help us towards our ministry goals and we have been fortunate to have two amazing groups already this year including the one from Timothy Christian school.

We would appreciate it if you could pray for God's protection for our staff as they serve, and (in many cases) live in gang-controlled neighborhoods, and for God's permanent provision for our ministry through our donors. Will you also please pray for God's blessing over our dream of starting a new bilingual school project next year with our first bilingual 1st grade class?

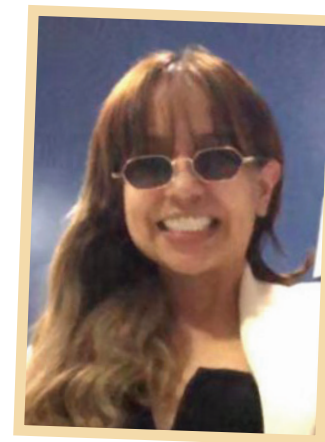
